To Whom this May Concern,

Thank you for providing West Valley Arborists with the opportunity to review your property. At the request of the owner, a site visit was made to 17064 Shady Lane Dr., to catalog twenty nine (29) trees and evaluate them in terms of health and structure.

As viewed, no station markers or other indicators of proposed construction were seen or fences indicating property line boundaries. The site plan provided indicated a small square which, on site, was a shed or small building and this was used as a point of reference for this tree survey.

Twenty nine (29) trees were measured, evaluated and provided with numbered aluminum tags for identification.

Tree Protection – As no station markers were available, tree protection must be understood in general terms. Construction should be at least 7-8 feet from protected trees. Trees within the footprint of construction may need removal permits, so please inquire to local authorities regarding such trees. Protective GFT chain link fence is standard for tree protection and should be placed at least 7-8 feet in a circular pattern around protected trees. Some trees may be fenced in groups to provide a group tree protection zone – TPZ. No grade changes, storage, traffic, rock cobbles or hardscape should take place in the TPZ as soil compaction can kill roots vital to tree health. Any cutting of roots should be done under the authority of a Certified Arborist to ISA standards and consideration of anchorage loss, etc. be taken into consideration – access for equipment may involve pruning for vertical clearance and should be done with the help of a Certified ISA Arborist.
