ORDINANCE NO. 617

NO FEE

AN ORDINANCE ABANDONING CERTAIN LAND
PREVIOUSLY DEDICATED FOR PUBLIC PARK
PURPOSES

* * *

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Tuolumne do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Heretofore, on July 16, 1968, a subdivision map of Emerald Ranch Farms, Unit No. 1, was filed in Volume 3 of Subdivisions at page 65, Tuolumne County Records, and shown thereon, and by such filing dedicated to public use for park purposes, was a parcel of land described as follows:

All that real property situated in the State of California in the unincorporated area of the County of Tuolumne, being a portion of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 11, T. 1 N., R. 15 E., M. D. B. & M., more particularly described as follows:

All that certain parcel of land shown as "Recreation Area" on a subdivision map of Emerald Ranch Farms, Unit No. 1, filed July 16, 1968, in Volume 3 of Subdivisions at page 65, Tuolumne County Records, and containing 2.1 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2: This Board hereby finds and determines that the above-described land is not generally used by the public for park purposes, that no public funds have been expended to improve the same as a park, that no consideration has been paid for such land by any public agency, and that the public interest will be served by such abandonment.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to the provisions of California Government Code Section 25561, this Board of Supervisors hereby abandons, on behalf of the public, the hereinabove described real property.
